

## **The “Free Admissions” Thursday Overnight Stay Package (Based on room availability)**

\*\*\*\*Please be aware that all museums and the art gallery in Ottawa have **free admission** on Thursday late afternoons and evenings. This may provide another option for your class in the evening should you choose to come on a Thursday.

**The total cost for the Day Field Trip Visit plus the Thursday Overnight Stay accommodations with Friday breakfast is \$50.00 per person.**

## **The Regular Overnight Stay Package From One to Four Nights**

Teachers and School Leaders are invited to contact us to tailor your visit and the length of your stay specific to the needs and interests of your class/group. The One Day Field Trip Visit would serve as a basic template that can be re-worked for each day of the visit. In the evenings we can arrange some special guest speakers to visit, or have extra worship and/or prayer times

Arrival times can be in the morning, afternoon or after supper and the length of your stay can vary from one night and up to four nights, Monday – Friday. We have had some schools already come and stay for the entire week, and some other schools have just stayed for an overnight. We recommend a visit for at least a couple of nights for full benefit. How can we best serve you?

**The cost is \$50.00 per person per day and includes your overnight accommodation plus three meals.**

This also includes Bible Instruction (see previous page for topic selection), Practical Prayer Workshops, the Parliament Hill Prayer Walk and Parliament Hill Activities. Depending on the length of your stay, more time could allow for all of the Parliament Hill activities plus possible additional visits to the Supreme Court of Canada, The Senate and the Governor General’s Residence.
